### INVITATION FOR BIDS (IFB)

- 1. This Invitation for Bids (IFB) follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) for this project that appeared in UNDB online on 11 May 2010.
- 2. The Republic of Croatia has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development toward the cost of Justice Sector Support Project, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the agreement(s) resulting from this IFB: Supply and Installation of the Generic Cabling (local computer and telephony network and power supply installations) (No. G-2).
- 3. The Project Implementation Unit of the Ministry of Justice serves as the implementing agency for the project and now invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the supply and installation of the generic cabling for the justice sector institutions, including computer local area network, telephony network and power supply installations.
  - The supply and installation period is 24 weeks from contract effectiveness.
- 4. Bidding will be conducted using the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits, edition of *May 2004*, *revised October 1, 2006*, and is open to all Bidders eligible as defined in these Guidelines, that meet the following minimum qualification criteria:

#### (i) Experience

During the past four (4) years, the Bidder must have completed two (2) successful contracts involving the supply and installation Local Area Networks with at least two thousand (2.000) network connections (ports) per contract

#### (ii) Technical capacity

The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence to demonstrate that it will have technical capacity to supply and install Information Technologies included in the Bid. To be considered responsive to this requirement the Bidder must provide a minimum of three (3) work teams with at least three (3) members (project leader excluded) working on generic cable system installation; at least two (2) of the work team members must have minimum of two (2) years experience at jobs similar to the ones required by the project.

Minimum of three (3) staff members must be certified and of appropriate level of expertise for installation of the Information Technologies included in the Bid.

The technical experience and qualifications of Subcontractors can count for the provision of installation services.

#### (iii) Financial viability

- a) The Bidder shall demonstrate average annual turnover during the **last 3 years** of at least **USD 4 000 000 (four million US Dollars)** equivalent.
- b) The Bidder shall be properly established in its country of origin, the Bidder and management staff of the company shall have not been sentenced for commercial crime(s), the Bidders shall have stable financial position and shall have fulfilled its obligations as to payment of taxes and duties in the country of incorporation.

#### (iv) Manufacturer's experience

The manufacturer of the Information Technologies offered shall be certified for compliance with ISO 9001 or equivalent standards for quality management.

- 5. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from **Project Implementation Unit of the Ministry of Justice** and inspect the bidding documents at the address given below from **09:00 to 16:00 hours on the normal business days.**
- 6. A complete set of bidding documents in *English* may be obtained by interested Bidders on submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of *HRK 730,00 (Croatian Kuna seven hundred thirty)* or *EUR 100,00 (Euro one hundred)*. The method of payment will be wire transfer to the following bank account:

The document will be sent by *courier mail or may be collected by Bidder's representative from PIU office at the address below*. For the convenience of Bidders an unofficial electronic copy of the Bidding Documents *in MS Word format may also be forwarded by electronic mail.* 

- 7. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before 12.00 hours local time on 1 February 2011. Bids need to be secured by a Bid Security. The amount of Bid Security required is: HRK 60 000,00 (Croatian Kuna sixty thousand) or an equivalent in a freely convertible currency. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below immediately after the deadline for bid submission.
- 8. The attention of prospective Bidders is drawn to (i) the fact that they will be required to certify in their bids that all software is either covered by a valid license or was produced by the Bidder and (ii) that violations are considered fraud, which can result in ineligibility to be awarded World Bank-financed *contracts*.
